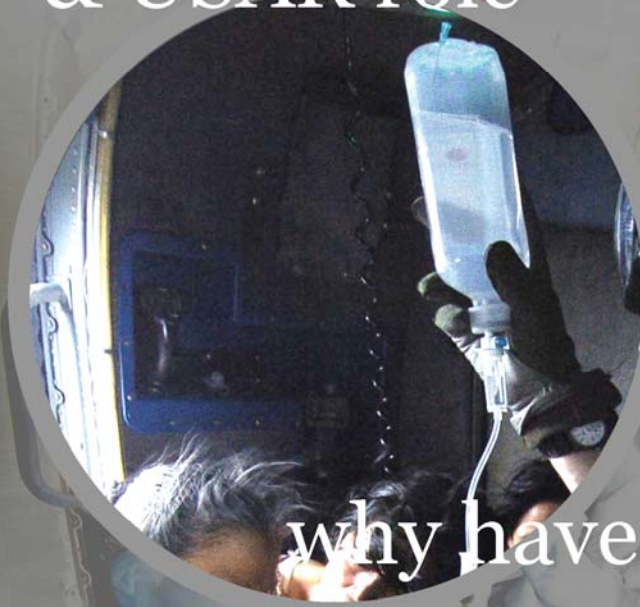

collie clip from pointflame services

at the scene of an RTA/MVA , free up your hands to do something else !



a **collie clip** with its IV accessory and 6kg. closing force in the primary jaws will easily clip onto a paramedic coat or vest, holding the IV bag and so keeping hands free to carry oxygen, litter etc.

here with the airway management accessory attached the **collie clip** will keep the airway tube in place and thus the mask.

during ambulance transportation of the patient this allows the paramedic to carry out other tasks essential to the wellbeing of the patient



attach it to a vehicle, a branch or a reinforcement rod. whatever the scenario a **collie clip** will nine times out of ten provide the extra pair of hands required to save another life.
